SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have approached this Court *inter-alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to provide them protection from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 11.
2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners have attained the age of majority and are in a live-in-relationship. He submits that the private respondents, who are relatives of petitioner No.1, are extending threats to them and the petitioners apprehend a risk to their life and liberty.



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3. Notice of motion, restricted to respondents No.1 to 3.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Aman Bahri, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. He has placed on record a *Xerox* copy of the statements of respondent No.4 and 5, who are the parents of the petitioner No.1, to submit that both the aforesaid respondents have stated that they do not have any objection, in case, the petitioners get married.
5. Mr. Gourav Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 and has filed Memorandum of Appearance, which is taken on record. He submits that an FIR has been registered against respondent No.2 alleging that he has illegally confined petitioner No.1 in a secret place.
6. Be that as it may, as respondents No.4 and 5 do not have any objection to the relationship and matrimony of the petitioners, petition is disposed of. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach this Court again, in case, they apprehend any threat to their life and liberty in future.
