This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 as they are repeatedly calling the petitioners to the CIA office Karnal without any reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners No.1, 3 and 5 and respondent No.6 are siblings and petitioners No.2 and 4 are brothers in law of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.6. He submits that respondent No.6 used to harass the entire family members. On 29.06.2021, he submitted a false complaint before the SSP concerned against the petitioners by leveling false and fabricated allegations and the same was enquired into by the higher police officials and was found to be false. Thereafter, again respondent No.6 filed many complaints against the petitioners and they have been called many time by the police authorities. Now, respondent No.6 has again lodged FIR No.213 dated 14.03.2022 under Sections 406, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Karnal Sadar, District Karnal.

They are again being harassed at the hands of local police authorities. He submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is given to the competent authority to look into the matter and the representation dated 17.06.2024 (Annexure P8) is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Saurabh Girdhar, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State. Counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply a copy of the complete paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Heard.

In view of the limited prayer made and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and to decide the representation dated 17.06.2024 (Annexure P8) within 02 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law and to provide necessary protection to the petitioners in case situation so warrants.
