Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the Notice No.108/SIT dated 07.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) issued under Section 91 Cr.P.C. by respondent No.2, the Special Investigating Team in FIR No.02 dated 20.12.2021 registered under Sections 25, 27-A, 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station State Crime, SAS Nagar.
