1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of subsequent possession notice dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent No.3.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has pointed out that in the present case, against the impugned order/notice dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P-2), statutory appeal under Section 17 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002 is maintainable whereas in para 17 of the writ petition, it has been averred that there is no other alternative and efficacious



remedy and there is no provision of appeal or revision against the impugned action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the said stand, he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to seek alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
