The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.0023, dated 20.03.2024, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kurali City, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

This Court vide order dated 20.06.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation and also directed the State to verify the medical condition of the petitioner.

In compliance of the abovesaid order, a status report by way of an affidavit of Dharamvir Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar-II, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) has been filed on behalf of the respondent/State, which is taken on record, wherein in para 6 it has been reported that the petitioner is suffering from bladder cancer which is

supported by report dated 27.07.2024 at Annexure R-2 issued by PGIMER, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 20.06.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.06.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
