SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is *inter alia* for issuance of a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the pending revision petition bearing No.82-2023 titled as Krishan Ram Versus Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, Annexure P-6, in a time bound manner and to stay the further proceedings pursuant to orders, Annexures P-4 and P-5, passed by respondents No.3 and 2, respectively.
2. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the State.



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3. Upon instructions from Mr. Dharambir Singh, ADA, Cooperation Department, Haryana, State counsel has submitted that the revision petition came up for hearing before Additional Chief Secretary Corporation, Haryana, on 04.04.2024 and has been admitted. He submits that notice has been issued to the parties for 08.08.2024.

4. In M. Gopalakrishnan and others Versus Pasumpon Muthuramalingam and another 2024 (1) R.C.R. (Criminal) 864, Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed that before passing any order for expeditious disposal of the proceedings, it would be appropriate for the higher Court to appreciate that any such order in one case might upset the calender and schedule of the subordinate Court and result in assigning unwarranted priority to a particular case over and above other cases.

5. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn.
