1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 for counting the previous services of the petitioners rendered on work charged basis for the purpose of revised pensionary benefits, although they are still in service except petitioner No.1.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from the respondents, submits that the petitioners have furnished the necessary documents and their case is under consideration which shall be finalised shortly.
3. Since the claim of the petitioners is already under consideration before the respondents, therefore, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
5. The respondents shall consider and finalise the claim of the petitioners within a period of four months.
