By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 24.06.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required



for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 24.06.2024 the following order was passed:-

“Inter alia contends that the petitioner is a young man aged about 19 years with no criminal antecedents; petitioner has been falsely implicated into the FIR in question on account of party faction & the petitioner is willing to join investigation and cooperate therein.

In order to buttress his arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the dicta of the judgements of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the case of ‘Md. Asfak Alam versus The State of Jharkhand and another’ 2023(3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 754 and Arnesh Kumar versus State of Bihar (2014) 8 SCR 128.

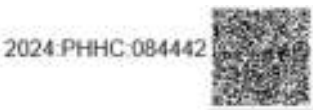
Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 08.07.2024.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 27.06.2024 at 11:00 A.M. in concerned Police Station and join investigation. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when further called by Investigating Officer, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the condition(s) enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 24.06.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 24.06.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will



influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
