The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for protecting his life and liberty which according to him is at stake. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the private respondents are extending threats to the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the private respondents abducted his adopted daughter namely Manpreet Kaur @ Manu from the house of the petitioner on 11.03.2024. The petitioner has submitted a complaint dated 31.05.2024 to the police authority regarding illegal confinement of his daughter but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 at this stage.

Mr. Manmeet Singh Teji, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 3. Since no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed, therefore, there is no necessity of inviting any response.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, as well as keeping in view the fact that there is question of illegal confinement, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the matter and pass an appropriate order in the representation allegedly filed by the petitioner before him on 31.05.2024 (Annexure P-2). It would be appreciated if necessary orders are passed within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Till then, protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.
