This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter alia, contends that feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No. 4 to 8 and apprehending threats to their life and liberty, instant petition has been preferred and the petitioners have also moved a representation dated 18.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, District Panchkula, but till date no action thereon has been taken.



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- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and she has submitted that the statements of the private respondents has been recorded at Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula, and the same is marked as Annexure ‘A’. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners as well.
- 5. Learned counsel for the petitioners has gone through the statements and has stated that in view of the statements given by the private respondents No. 4 and 5, he intends to withdraw this petition at this stage.
- 6. In view of the above, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
