1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CWP-22645-2017.
2. Short affidavit of Kamaljeet Singh, Executive Engineer, PWD, B & R, Malerkotla, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CWP-22645-2017 has since been complied with, and necessary payment has been made to the petitioner, as would decipher from the documents annexed with the above-said short affidavit.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
6. Since the main case has been rendered infructuous, therefore, the pending application under Order 1 Rule 10 read with Section 151 CPC is also disposed of being infructuous.
