GURBIR SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25, dated 15.02.2024, under Sections 323, 427, 447, 506, 148, 149 of IPC (Sections 325, 307 and 452 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.
2. Vide order dated 24.06.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljeet Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 24.06.2024, petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant submits that he seeks one week's time to produce videography in order to prove some factual aspects of the matter.

4.1 His request is considered and declined keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his further custody is no more required.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 24.06.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

7. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
