1. The present application has been filed seeking exemption from filling the Aadhar card of petitioner.

2. For the reasons assigned in the application, the same is allowed.

Main case

3. Through the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.07 dated 29.01.2024, Under Sections 451/427 IPC (offence under Section 451(II) IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Khui Khera, District Fazilka.

2. The allegations against the petitioner are that on 28.01.2024, he entered into the fuel petrol pump belonging to M/s Siag Fuel Station

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and damaged the fuel machine as well as the glasses of the petrol pump and ran away.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner in the asking for the relief submit that infact the present FIR has been registered after twisting the facts and with due deliberations and concoction. She further submits that a free fight took place between the petitioner and the three employee of the petrol pump, who attacked the petitioner and caused injuries on his head and back and the petitioner in order to save himself threw brick bats and stones out of which some hit on the glass of the petrol pump and, therefore, the instant FIR has been registered. She further submits that the genesis of the occurrence has been twisted. She also submits that the petitioner was arrested in the instant matter on 13.5.2024 and the matter is still under investigation.

4. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate today in the Court, which is taken on record. A perusal of the same reflects that the petitioner has suffered incarceration of 1 month and 20 days as on today and has clean antecedents. Learned State counsel on instructions further submits that the investigation is still under way.

5. Considering the nature of the allegations and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as considering the fact that the case is still at initial stage and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner, this Court deems it fit and appropriate to extend the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner. Therefore, the present petition is **allowed.**



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6. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

7. However, anything observed here-in-above shall have no effect on the merits of the case and is meant for deciding the present petition only.
