Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondent authorities to submit the action taken report on the complaint dated 17.10.2016 against respondent No.6, who has taken the Government job on the basis of forged, fabricated and false 8th Class certificate.

Reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 had been filed, as per which respondent No.6 had been appointed as a Peon in the Office of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Abohar. An enquiry was conducted by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner (G), Fazilka on the allegations levelled in the complaint against respondent No.6 and the same were found to be false. It was thus specifically noticed that as on the date when respondent No.6 was

appointed as a Peon, the eligibility qualification for the post was Primary whereas he was 8th fail. It was also noticed that respondent No.6 never obtained any benefit of the alleged cutting in the 8th Class certificate in the service record and that statement of the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Sayad Wala, was also recorded as per which the petitioner is 8th Class fail and obtained the school leaving certificate by submitting the application dated 08.02.1978. The cutting in the official service record file of the petitioner is the result of the mischievous act. Even though the above said reply was filed by way of affidavit dated 13.10.2018, no replication or rejoinder controverting the same has been filed.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondent No.6.

It is evident from the perusal of order sheets that there has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last six dates successively. The matter has been adjourned to await appearance of the petitioner. The position remains unchanged today as well. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
