This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act and read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for non-compliance of the order dated 20.05.2015 passed by SDM, Batala.

Since, the order qua which the contempt is alleged in the present petition has been passed by the Assistant Collector dealing with the issue of mutation, therefore, the contempt petition for alleged non-compliance would simply not be maintainable.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
