1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.117 dated 05.10.2023 under Sections 452, 323, 160, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.
2. The instant petition has been dismissed as not pressed qua petitioner No.1-Charno, vide order dated 24.06.2024.
3. On 24.06.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to petitioner No.2- Parminder Kumar @ Ajay, and asked him to join investigation:-

“As regards petition qua petitioner No.2 is concerned, learned counsel inter alia submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, petitioner No.2 has been shown to be armed with datar, but no injury has been attributed to him. He further submits that petitioner No.2 is ready to join the investigation.”

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4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 24.06.2024, petitioner No.2-Parminder Kumar @ Ajay, has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, does not dispute the factum of petitioner No.2-Parminder Kumar @ Ajay having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 24.06.2024, is made absolute qua petitioner No.2-Parminder Kumar @ Ajay, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

7. The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
