1. Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking the relief of regular bail by the petitioner in case FIR No.49, dated 16.11.2023, under Sections 21, 25 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, (Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 201 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Special Operation Cell, Amritsar, District Intelligence Wing (CID).

2. The earlier petition bearing no.CRM-M-19342-2024, was ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, by this Court vide order dated 23.05.2024, and only after 20 days thereof, the instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for the same cause of action by change of counsel, without awaiting the further progress of the trial.

3. Today, learned State counsel has filed a short reply, 12.08.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh.Balbir Singh, DSP, Counter Intelligence, Amritsar, alongwith the custody certificate *qua* the petitioner, which are taken on record, with copies thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. The reply (*supra*), reflects that in the instant FIR the total recovery effected is 3.5 kg.of heroin, and the petitioner is involved in two other criminal cases, one of which is under the provisions of NDPS Act. Petitioner was arrested in this case only on 01.12.2023.

4. In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant the petitioner the relief of regular bail. Consequently, the instant petition is hereby **dismissed**.
