This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant salary and other allownaces as well as pension to the members of Municipal Council/Committees/Corporations.

Learned counsel for the State and respondent No.3-Municipal Council have submitted that the Mayors, Senior Deputy Mayors, Deputy Mayors, Members of Municipal Corporations, President, Vice President and Members of Municipal Council/Committee are being paid honorarium and allowances as admissible under the law from the municipal fund since 1995

and same are constantly revised by the State Government, reference in this regard has been made to Annexures R-1 to R-3 annexed with the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. It is further submitted that there is no provision in any Act, nor any Rules/Regulation which requires the respondents to pay salary, pension to the members of the Municipal Council/Committee/Corporation.

Today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners in order to rebut the abovesaid averments.

Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

Liberty is however, granted to the petitioners to revive the present Civil Writ Petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives to the petitioners.
