ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

1. On 20.06.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of writ of Habeas Corpus for appointment of a warrant officer to raid the premises of respondents No.3 to 6 to recover the detenues, namely, Yugraj Singh aged about 20 years, Harmanbeer Singh aged about 16 years sons of the petitioner from the illegal confinement of respondents No.3 to 6 and further directions be issued to the official respondents to produce the detenues before this Court. Further prayer has been made to appoint a warrant officer with a roving writ for effecting the search for release of the detenues wherever they are or grant any other relief which this Court may deem fit. Further prayer has been made for taking action against respondents No.3 to 6 for keeping the detenues in illegal confinement.

Notice of motion for 25.06.2024.

In the meantime, Registry is directed to depute a responsible Officer of this Court as a Warrant Officer, who would ascertain as to whether abovesaid detenues have been illegally detained by respondents No.3 to 6, as contended by the petitioner. And if so, to get them released from such illegal detention. The fees/expenses of the Warrant Officer, to be assessed by the Registry, shall be borne by the petitioner. Upon deposit of the amount as may be quantified by the Registry, the

Warrant Officer shall discharge his duty and submit his report to this Court on the next date of hearing.”

2. The Warrant Officer has submitted his report, which reads as under:-

“It is apt to mention here that all of the sudden when Mala who is standing outside the Police Station Sadar, Amritsar at District Amritsar came inside the police station is accompanying the detenue namely, Yugraj Singh and Harmanbeer Singh. In the meanwhile Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar namely Sadar Harpal Singh reached to the said police station to whom I apprised about the orders passed by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court. Thereafter, since the said detenue-Yugraj Singh & Harmanbeer Singh who are accompanying her mother i.e., the petitioner-Mala inside the police station to whom before handing over the said detenue-Yugraj Singh & Harmanbeer Singh a common disclosure statement was recorded in the presence of Mala- petitioner and the undersigned along with the police officer/officials.”

3. In view of the aforesaid, the petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
