1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the order dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by the respondents and further to direct the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner in accordance with law.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the services of the petitioner have been regularized vide order dated 14.03.2024 but he has not been given the date of regularization which was given to the similarly situated persons i.e. Gian Chand and some other persons.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submitted that the aforesaid grievance of the petitioner with regard to the change of date of regularization can be considered by the competent authority within a period of two months from today.
4. In view of the above, the concerned competent authority is directed to pass a well reasoned speaking order with regard to the grievance of the petitioner concerning the date of regularization in view of the aforesaid submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that similarly situated persons have been granted regularization from earlier date, within a period of three months from today. Needless to say that the order shall be a well reasoned speaking order and it shall be in accordance with law.
5. Consequently, the present writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
