1. Instant criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7. Further prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 20.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fazilka (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 20.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

3. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
