The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No.2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner and her minor children at the behest of respondent No.6 and other police personnel.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Litesh Rai, District Jalandhar and ASI Anil Kumar, Amritsar City, District Amritsar submits that one FIR No.148 dated 23.05.2023 under Section 21(c) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 was registered against the husband of the present petitioner and others.

The Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing, District SAS Nagar had questioned the petitioner twice in connection with the investigation of the said case, thereafter the petitioner was never called by any police officer. He further submits that in case the involvement of the petitioner is found in any criminal case, a notice in writing shall be issued to her and the procedure established by law shall be followed by the police. Learned State counsel further submits that the police has investigated the abovesaid FIR fairly and impartially.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
