The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take action against the accused persons in FIR No.46 dated 29.04.2023, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Phase 11, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali and to conclude the investigation at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harnek Singh, submits that there are total 04 accused in the instant FIR namely Dixit Sood, Abhishek Jalan, Komal Saluja and Varun. He submits that Dixit Sood has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court and he has already joined the investigation and Abhishek Jalan and Komal Saluja, have also been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 13.05.2024, passed in SLP (Crl.) Diary No.16525 of 2024 and they are yet to join the investigation in terms of



the said order. He further submits that after they joined the investigation, necessary action shall be taken with regard to the fourth accused namely Varun.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition is disposed of as the claim raised in the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition, if no action is taken against the accused Varun.
