RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed with Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the orders dated 28.04.2021 and 30.06.2021 passed in CWP-PIL-77-2021.
2. The previous order dated 28.03.2022 has not been complied with so far. Otherwise also, there is nothing on record to show that the order has been violated by the respondents.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
