1 Prayer in this appeal is for setting aside order dated 23.05.2022 whereby writ petition filed by the respondents herein was allowed while directing that total length of service rendered by writ petitioners be taken into account as qualifying service for computing pensionary benefits subject to deposit of contribution by petitioners for the period it was not deposited, along with interest.

2. It is noted at this stage that a set of 16 writ petitions were decided vide impugned order dated 23.05.2022. LPA No.521 of 2023 arising out of CWP No.24322 of 2016 which was decided alongwith, was admittedly dismissed on 01.05.2023 while concluding that delay in filing of said appeal which was 367 days, was not satisfactorily explained.



3. There is a delay of 373 days in filing of instant appeal. Learned counsel for appellant is unable to indicate any point of distinction which should compel us to cause interference in the present identical matter decided by the common impugned order dated 01.05.2023.
4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as narrated above, application seeking condonation of delay as well as appeal are dismissed.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
