RITU TAGORE, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioner is the wife of respondent No.4 has filed the instant petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of direction in the nature of mandamus to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hand of private respondents No.4 (husband) and 5 Jeth (brother-in-law).

2. Marriage of the petitioner was solemnized about 12 years ago and out of the wedlock two girls were born, who are aged 11 years and 5 years respectively. According to petitioner, after the birth of second daughter, the acts and conduct of respondent No.4 became cruel towards her. He started misbehaving, harassing, beating her on various pretexts & threatening her with dire consequences and started drinking excessive alcohol. On 10.06.2024 respondents No.4 and 5 threw the petitioner and her minor daughters out of the house. But

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with the intervention of the respectables of the locality the matter was reconciled and respondent No.4 allowed the petitioner to enter the house. But again, without any reason on 11.06.2024 she was forcibly thrown out from the matrimonial home by giving her beatings alongwith her minor daughter. It is stated that presently she is residing in the house of her known friend/relative namely Vishambhar son of Ram Naresh in the same society at House No.89, New Palam Vihar, District Gurugram, Haryana. It is thus prayed that she apprehend threat to her life and liberty and also moved the representation dated 23.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) in this regard.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Safia Gupta, AAG, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. She submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation, if any, of the petitioner in accordance with law.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Gurgaon, Haryana to consider representation dated 23.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) and to take remedial measures to protect life and liberty of petitioner if so warranted, in accordance with law.

6. It is further made clear that if the petitioner is otherwise found to be involved in any other case, in such an eventuality, this order shall not preclude the competent authority from taking appropriate



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action against the petitioner, that law permits.
