KIRTI SINGH, J. (Oral)

The jurisdiction of this Court under under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been invoked for grant of regular bail or in the alternative grant of interim bail for six months to the petitioner in case FIR No.72 dated 02.04.2024 under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

2. Vide order dated 15.07.2024, learned State counsel was directed to file the status report verifying the factual aspect of the illness of the petitioner.
3. Reply dated 30.07.2024 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Vijay Kumar, Superintendent Women Jail, Ludhiana has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.



4. Learned State counsel refers to Annexure R-1 annexed with reply:

“This is to submit that the under trial inmate Manjit Kaur w/o Late Sher Singh is confined in Women Jail, Ludhiana on 05.04.2024 as new admission. She is K/C/O Multiple Myeloma with Parkinson's Disease. She was being referred to Rajindra Hospital Patiala for Injection Zolendronic Acid 3mg. On 13.05.2024. She was referred to PGI Chandigarh for Blood Investigation. After that she was being referred to PGI Chandigarh regularly for Chemotherapy on 29.05.2024, 07.06.2024. 14.06.2024, 20.06.2024, 02.07.2024, 09.07.2024 and 19.07.2024 with CR NO:202204175267. Also she is regularly being Monitored in Women Jail Dispensary for Diabetes Mellitus and other Mild ailments like Cough, fever and sorethroat.

On 30.05.2024 at 11:15 AM she complained of weakness for which she was referred to Civil Hospital Ludhiana as Emergency case. There, she was managed appropriately by Emergency Doctor on duty with Emergency No.24095/24. She was advised to attend follow up in Medicine OPD Next day.

On 31.05.2024, she had attended Medicine OPD at Civil Hospital Ludhiana with Vide OPD No 2100112400955402. Where she was prescribed medicine for her C/O tremors weakness.

Now presently her vitals are reassuring. She is ambulatory on examination.

5. Considering the fact that petitioner is 72 years old lady and is suffering from 4th stage of cancer, this Court is of the view that the petitioner is entitled to concession of interim bail at this stage. Accordingly, petition stands



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allowed and petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of 04 weeks from the date of his actual release, on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
