1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay overtime allowance in terms of regulations No.35 and 36 of para (iv) of Pepsu Road Transport Corporation (Conditions of Appointment & Service Regulation), 1981.
2. Notice of motion was issued and Sh. Anupam Singla, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for claiming the same relief representation dated 04.06.2021 (Annexure P-5) was submitted by the petitioners which is still pending consideration with the respondents. She submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied, if appropriate directions may be issued to the respondents to consider and decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
5. In view of the above, respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners for grant of overtime allowance as narrated in the representation dated 04.06.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are found entitled for the grant of overtime allowance, the necessary benefit shall be released to them within a period of one month thereafter.
6. The petition stands disposed of.
