1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 04.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) whereby he has been awarded punishment of severe reprimand.
2. Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that petitioner has alternative remedy to approach Armed Force Tribunal and this Court vide order dated 03.10.2023 passed in CWP No.3118 has already held that in such cases, the petition is maintainable before Armed Force Tribunal.
3. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of in terms of order dated 03.10.2023 passed by this Court in CWP No.3118. The Registry is directed to transfer complete paper book of this case to Registrar, AFT, Chandigarh. At the first instance, the parties shall appear before AFT, Chandigarh on 02.04.2024.
