1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.125 dated 08.04.2024 under Sections 387, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

2. On 09.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR in question and there was no suspicion raised qua his involvement in the alleged crime i.e of blackmailing the complainant, who was put in fear of dire consequences as he had been telephoning the sister of the complainant.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 09.07.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 09.07.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
