This is an application under Section 151 CPC for preponement of the date of hearing from 09.05.2024 to some early date.

This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to grant family pension and other pensionary benefits to the present petitioner along with interest @ 12% per annum since the date of death of her husband i.e., 29.01.2006.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently, the rejection / reply dated 26.07.2021 (Annexure P-8) has not

been challenged in the present petition and thus, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after challenging the said rejection /reply.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
