AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Neelam and Parveen Kumar have filed present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

2. Learned counsel for petitioners conceded that petitioner No.1 was earlier married and her husband has expired. However, death certificate of her first husband is not placed on record. It is further conceded that petitioner No.2 is also married having children. They are apprehending threats from respondents No.4 and 5 who are brother and brother-in-law of petitioner No.1 respectively. It is pointed out that they had filed representation before Superintendent of Police, Karnal and Station House Officer, Police Station Nissing dated 23.06.2024 (Annexure P-3). He is only seeking direction that the aforesaid representation be

disposed of by the police.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State. Complete copy of paperbook along with supporting documents is already supplied.
5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to dispose of representation of petitioners dated 23.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) considering threat perception, if any.
6. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
