4. Be that as it may, the aforesaid assertions and submissions clearly indicate that trial is likely to take long time where none of the witnesses have been examined despite lapse of more than one year after framing of charges before the trial Court and no fruitful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, which would amount to infringement of his right to life and personal liberty, as enshrined under Article 21 of Constitution of India and is against the principle "bail is a rule" and "jail is an exception".
5. In the light of above discussions made hereinabove, similarly situated co-accused, Himmat has been granted concession of regular bail and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
6. The present petition is, hereby, allowed.
7. However, it is made clear that anything stated hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
