Petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in criminal complaint No.24/2017 titled as “Balwinder Kumar Vs Dharamveer @ Ghug etc.”, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 452, 120-B read with Sections 149, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

2. It transpires that petitioner was granted interim concession by this Court on 14.07.2023, but despite that, he failed to join the proceedings before learned trial Court. Again on 01.12.2023, petitioner was granted time to do the needful.

3. Today, learned counsel submits that despite his best efforts, petitioner is not inclined to join the proceedings.

4. In view of the above, there is no option except to dismiss the petition.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. Needless to say that interim concession granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.07.2023 and extended from time to time, shall come to an end automatically.
