

Vijay Kumar Vs. Kulbir Singh and others

As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.4,25,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Learned counsel for the appellant has given a statement before this Forum that after the death of claimant-appellant-Vijay Kumar, his LRs were already brought on the record vide order dated 29.07.2013 passed by the Hon'ble High Court. Now one of the LRs Switri Devi has also expired and as per the instructions, there is no need to implead the LRs of Switri Devi except the LRs detailed earlier, namely, Ritu Bala, Sneha and Rahul (widow and children of Vijay Kumar). As per instructions, the payment be made to Ritu Bala widow of Vijay Kumar. The amended memo of parties is being filed.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.4,25,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only) in the name of Ritu Bala widow of Vijay Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 20.03.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
