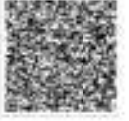

JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.136 dated 18.04.2024 registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Ambala Cantt.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been arrived at between the petitioner on the one hand and the victims Ravinder Singh son of Gurmel Singh and Ravi Kumar son of Krishan Lal on the other. In terms of the said compromise, the complainants would have no objection if the petitioner is granted concession of bail. The copy of the compromise/affidavit dated 05.07.2024 is marked as X. As he is in custody since 29.05.2024, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him incarcerated and therefore, he is entitled to the concession of bail.

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3. The learned State counsel has not disputed the factual situation.
4. The learned counsel for the complainants Ravinder Singh and Ravi Kumar accompanied by the complainants themselves submits that as a settlement has been arrived at between the parties, the complainants have no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.
5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the fact that a compromise has been effected between the parties and the petitioner is in custody since 29.05.2024, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-Sanjeev Kaushik son of Vijay Kumar is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
