MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.11 dated 07.03.2024 under Section 336 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27, 29, 30 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. On 29.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR in question; he came to be nominated as an accused on the basis of disclosure statement allegedly suffered by the main accused Gurdeepak Singh after two months of the alleged occurrence. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.”

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 29.07.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurminder Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 29.07.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
