1. Prayer in this Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos.3 to 7.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the representation dated 23.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Deepak Malhotra, Advocate appearing for Mr. S.D. Malhotra, APP, U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 2.
5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner and issue necessary directions accordingly.
6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
