1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.05.2022 passed in CWP-14942-1999.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Anand Mohan Sharan, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents has referred to the aforesaid compliance report and has submitted that necessary benefits have already been granted to the petitioner. There has not been any change in the amount of pension payable to the petitioner on account of compliance of the order, whereas, the arrears which arose on account of revised benefits have already been paid to the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

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5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

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1. Since the main petition has already been decided, the present application has become infructuous.
2. Dismissed as having become infructuous.
