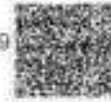
SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
169	13.06.2024	323, 34 and 506 of IPC and Section 75 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 added later on.	City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 15.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 15.07.2024 .

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI Harjeet, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and



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is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial investigation.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of counsel for the complainant opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. During the course of hearing on 15.07.2024 , following order was passed:

“2. *Heard.*

3. *Admittedly, the allegations against the petitioner are of giving fist blow and the offence in the FIR are bailable except for offence under Section 506 IPC. No recovery is to be effected from the petitioner.*

4. *In these circumstances, without comment on the merits, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within 7 days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

5. *List on 26.07.2024.”*

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 15.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 15.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating



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Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
