NAMIT KUMAR J. (Oral)

1. Instant criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 13.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 22.06.2024 (Annexure P-9) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for his life and liberty.
3. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously within a period of 15 days from today, in accordance with law.
