1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant one notional annual increment to the petitioner who was entitled for grant of annual increment on 1st July of the respective year and retired prior to 1st July of the respective year and has completed more than 6 months of service and has not been granted the annual increment with a further prayer to direct the respondents to revise the pay and pension of the petitioner and draw all the pensionery benefits alongwith interest @ 18 % per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 29.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 and

3 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further



submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 29.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) is considered and decided by respondent No.2 and 3 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
