1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.200, dated 11.06.2024, under Sections 323,447,147,149,506,120-B,380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 05.08.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Dilbag Singh also submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the

parties, the interim order dated 05.08.2024 is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
