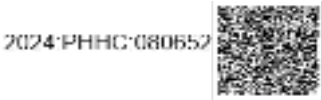

1. Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent Nos.1 & 3 not to falsely implicate the petitioner No.1 and his family members into a false criminal case of abduction of petitioner No.2 at the behest of private respondents No.4 to 8 and their relatives and friends.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-7) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.
3. Notice of motion.



4. Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
6. The present petition stands disposed of.
