SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the instant petition has been filed for quashing of impugned FIR No.119 dated 09.10.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 323, 313 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Women, Jind as also all proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a settlement dated 24.05.2022 (copy whereof has been appended as Annexure P-2 with the present petition).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner has, in order to show his *bona fide*, taken certain steps in terms of the compromise and even withdrawn certain petitions/cases filed by him.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that a compromise/settlement agreement dated 24.05.2022 had, in fact, been entered into between the parties but the same has fizzled out later on.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has thus submitted that since there is



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no subsisting compromise between the parties, the instant petition is liable to be dismissed on this score alone.

4. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail remedy(s) as available in law.

5. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed off.
