This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members from the hands of respondents No. 5 to 7 and to take action on the representation (Annexure P-6).

2. Status report by way of an affidavit dated 08.09.2024 of Sh. Gurdev Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana had been filed.

In the status report, the following has been stated :-

“3. That in compliance to the above noted order of this Hon'ble Court, it is respectfully submitted that Representation Annexure P-6 was moved by the petitioners with the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana bearing PGD No.391834/391225 dated 25.07.2024 for protection of life and liberty and for taking action against police officials. Enquiry the on said Representation of the petitioners was



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conducted by the answering deponent during which various persons including both the parties as well as police officials were joined in the enquiry and their statement were recorded. Various documents/record was compiled and perused. Ultimately it was revealed that neither there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners from anybody nor the police officials ever threatened/pressurised the petitioners to compromise the matter with the private respondents and nor any derogatory language was spoken by respondent no.7 against the caste of the petitioners.

However, peace keeping proceedings u/s 107/151 Cr.P.C. vide GDR No.07 dated 03.05.2024 were launched against respondent No. 7 by the police of Police Post Jagatpuri, Ludhiana. It is further submitted that petitioner no.1 had also produced one MLR showing four simple injuries on his and the same constitute offence u/s 323 IPC which is a Non- Cognizable offence and therefore GDR No.22 dated 27.07.2024 has also been lodged in this regard.

5. That thus in nutshell there was a quarrel between the parties on road in which petitioner No.1 had sustained simple injuries regarding which peace keeping proceedings were launched against respondent no.7 and GDR was also lodged as the same constitute non-cognizable offence u/s 323 IPC as detailed above. However, the rest of the allegations of the Spetitioners are false. Neither there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners from anybody nor the police officials ever threatened/pressurised the petitioners to compromise the matter with the private respondents and nor any derogatory language was spoken by respondent No.7 against the caste of the petitioners.”

3. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
