1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.11 dated 29.01.2024 for the offences under Section 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station City-I Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. On 01.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that false allegations have been levelled against the petitioner of having lured the complainant to part with a sum of ₹3.00 lacs on the pretext of providing his son with a Govt. job. Learned counsel submits that in fact there was a monetary dispute between the parties and the petitioner had paid back an amount of ₹50,000/- to the complainant and a cheque was also given in the said regard to the complainant, however, the complainant had come up with an entirely twisted version so as to falsely implicate the petitioner in the case at hand.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 01.07.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 01.07.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
