1. Petitioner Manohar Lal has filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of petitioner and his family members endangered at the hands of respondent No. 5 or any other direction which this Court may deem fit.

2. Mr. Ranjodh Singh Sidhu, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No. 5 and filed Memorandum of Appearance, which is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

3. Status report filed by respondent-State, which is taken on record. In status report, it is clarified that FIR No. 60 dated 29.05.2024, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983, Police Station NRI,

Amritsar has been registered against Balwinder Singh, Anita and Simranjit Kaur, who is daughter of petitioner. Matter is under investigation. No FIR has been lodged against present petitioner Manohar Lal. Police officials have not caused any kind of harassment to petitioner.

4. In view of aforesaid status report, no further action is required. Present protection petition stands disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
