1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.63 dated 28.03.2024, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.
2. By virtue of order dated 28.06.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.06.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
