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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioners (Col. Dharam Pal Singh Raghava and others) have filed the instant civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the resolution dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure P-2), passed by respondent No. 4 (District Development and Panchayat Officer, Sohna).
2. On advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears in the matter.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to approach the Director Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana (respondent No. 2) for the redressal of grievance of the petitioners, as stated in the instant writ petition. He further submits that time bound direction be issued to respondent No. 2 for decision of the representation, to be submitted by the petitioners.

4. In view of aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

5. The petitioners shall be at liberty to file a detailed representation, setting out the grievance to the Director Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana (respondent No. 2).

6. In case, any such representation is filed by the petitioners within a period of one week from today, Director Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana (respondent No. 2) shall take a decision thereon, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of representation, to be submitted by the petitioners.

7. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
